*What it does:* Using a Mary Kay-like direct-selling model, 5LINX sells voice over Internet protocol and cellular services to individuals and small businesses. *Why it's growing:* In the face of competition from huge cable companies selling VoIP, CEO Craig Jerabeck and his growing crew have focused on niche products—such as Internet-enabled videophones—which are pitched to consumers with friends and family overseas. *What's new:* When 5LINX made the 2006 Inc. 500, it was primarily reselling services provided by other companies and receiving commissions on each sale. Today it has its own VoIP network, which allows it to capture a greater share of revenue from each customer.

**Home Is Where the Sales Are**

5LINX (No. 336), a VoIP services provider, had always planned to sell to the immigrant market, but it anticipated growth among those from Latin America or the Caribbean. Then one of the company's sales reps started using the product to call his family in Cameroon, and orders from there began pouring in. In 2006, 5LINX derived \$2.5 million in revenue from Africa.
